SUBJECT: Leave Restriction Within the USARPAC Area of Operations for Operational Deployments

1. **References.**

- d. ALARACT 024/2015, Memorandum, Secretary of the Army, 26 January 2015, subject: Designation of Duty in Support of Operational Deployments and In-patient Hospitalized Soldiers as Qualifying Duty for Special Leave Accrual

2. **Applicability.** This policy applies to all active duty Army personnel assigned, attached, TDY or task organized under the United States Army Pacific (USARPAC) serving on an operational deployment within the USARPAC area of operations. It does not apply to permanent party personnel serving at their assigned duty station.

3. **Purpose.** To restrict authority for commanders to approve leave for Soldiers on Operational Deployments within the USARPAC area of operations.

4. **Policy.**

- a. Commanders are restricted from approving ordinary leave for active duty Soldiers serving on a duty assignment on orders in support of operational deployment missions within USARPAC area of operations IAW identified references. Exceptions must be submitted to USARPAC HQs for approval. Commanders may authorize leave under emergency conditions and parental leave.

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
b. Commanders must afford Soldiers maximum opportunity to take leave prior to departure for an operational deployment from their assigned unit or location.

c. This leave restriction was effective 26 January 2015.

d. Soldiers serving in leave restricted areas may be entitled to Special Leave Accrual (SLA) IAW Chap 3, AR 600-8-10, Rapid Action Revision (RAR) Issued: 4 August 2011. Requests for SLA must be submitted through the S-1 for processing through chain of command, to HRC for approval.
