MEMORANDUM FOR All 2d Infantry Division Command Teams

SUBJECT: Presence, participation and involvement in all SHARP training and events

1. References:

A. Department of Defense Instruction (DODI) 6495.02, Sexual Assault Prevention and Response (SAPR) Program Procedures, 28 March 2013, (Change 2, 20 January 2015).

B. Army Regulation (AR) 600-20, Army Command Policy, 6 November 2014.

C. Policy Letter #1-3, Sexual Harassment/Sexual Assault Response and Prevention (SHARP), 29 May 2014.

2. This policy applies to all Command Teams assigned to the 2d Infantry Division and it will be effective immediately. It remains in effect until rescinded or superseded.

3. Commander's Intent:

A. PURPOSE. Mandatory Command team presence at SHARP training/events in order to ensure the Soldiers and junior leaders know that the eradication sexual assault and harassment amongst our ranks is a priority and zero tolerance within the organization. Command teams will and are encouraged to participate to give experience and wisdom on prevention.

B. Key Tasks:

1. Commanders at all levels must support and ensure that this training is being conducted to standard. Leaders must be there to know this happens.

2. End State. For all 2ID Command Teams to diligently show their Soldiers and junior leaders that they care and support the SHARP program.

4. It is important that Leaders of the highest levels understand the impact of them participating with their soldiers on SHARP training/events, so Soldiers know they care. Therefore, all 2d Infantry Division Command Teams will participate in all mandatory, aggressive and progressive SHARP training.
