SUBJECT: Policy Letter #1-5, Army Continuing Education System (Warrior University)

2. This policy letter supersedes the 18 March 2014 Warrior University (WU) policy letter and remains in effect until specifically rescinded or superseded. It applies to all units and personnel assigned to 2ID.

3. Pursuing educational goals while balancing mission requirements is a challenging, but achievable endeavor. The objective of this policy is to make it possible for 2ID Soldiers, who are interested, to take advantage of the opportunity to advance their education and grow both personally and professionally.

4. The U.S. Army G-1 has granted all Soldiers assigned overseas a TA ETP to allow Soldiers to enroll in host nation history, language and cultural classes using TA inside the one-year time in service requirement after their Initial Entry Training (IET).

5. Warrior University opened to all 2ID personnel (military and Family members) on 18 January 2010. Effective immediately, there is a renewed Command emphasis on revitalizing this educational opportunity. Courses are available via the GoArmyEd

website, <https://www.goarmyed.com>. Soldiers may contact their supporting Education Center or Army Learning Center for information on other education programs and on financial assistance programs for themselves and their Family Members.

6. Soldiers attending Warrior University will not be placed on any duty that prevents their attendance in class. The first O5 Commander in the Service Member's chain of command has the authority to prevent a Soldier from attending class. In such cases, the serving Education Center will be notified.

7. 2ID Commanders at all levels will support Soldiers in pursuit of their educational goals to the maximum extent possible while meeting mission requirements, particularly, release of personnel actively attending WU classes Tuesday and Thursday. Commanders will consider both travel and class start-time when authorizing Soldiers for release. Locations and times of courses offered are:

- Casey/CRC – Classes, days and times:

1130 to 1300 – Monday thru Thursday

1500 to 1800 and/or 1830 to 2200- Tuesday & Thursday

1800-2200- Monday, Wednesday & Friday

0900 to 1700 – Saturday & Sunday

- Stanley/Hovey – Classes, days and times:

1130 to 1300 – Monday thru Thursday

1500 to 1800 and/or 1830 to 2200- Tuesday & Thursday

1800 to 2200 - Monday, Wednesday & Friday

0900 to 1700- Saturday & Sunday

- Yongsan/K16 – Classes, days and times:

1130 to 1300- Monday thru Thursday

1500 to 1800 and/or 1830 to 2200- Tuesday & Thursday
