SUBJECT: Policy Letter #7-1, Operations Security (OPSEC)

1. References.

2. This policy is effective immediately and remains in effect until rescinded or suspended.

3. Applicability. This policy applies to all 2ID military members, DoD Civilian employees, contractors and technical representatives, 2ID dependents and all those supporting 2ID operations.

4. The successful enforcement of OPSEC procedures prevents compromise, serious injury and possible death of 2ID service members or damage to our key mission essential assets, while protecting critical capabilities.

5. OPSEC is a command responsibility. Every member of the Division must practice OPSEC as a continuous disciplined habit on and off duty. I charge commanders and leaders at every level to train your forces and organizations to enforce a disciplined application of OPSEC.

6. I direct each Soldier, Airman, DoD civilian employee and contractor, at all levels, to maintain essential secrecy of information that could be exploited by our adversaries to plan,

prepare, and conduct activities against us. Safeguard critical and sensitive unclassified information from unauthorized access and disclosure while at rest and in transit.

7. Report the loss or compromise of critical and sensitive unclassified information to your unit OPSEC Officer.
