MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: General Order – Prohibition of Alcohol Consumption during Rotational Unit RIP/TOA

1. Purpose. To identify conduct that is prejudicial to good order and discipline and combat readiness of all forces and personnel assigned to 2d Infantry Division rotational units during the Relief in Place/Transfer of Authority (RIP/TOA) transition period.
2. Applicability. This order applies to all Soldiers assigned or attached to 2d Infantry Division rotational units (battalion size and above) while stationed in the Republic of Korea. This order is punitive and violations of its provisions may result in punitive and adverse administrative actions against service members. Failure to comply with this order is a violation of Article 92, UCMJ.
3. Prohibitions. Alcohol consumption is prohibited for all Soldiers assigned to rotational units during the RIP/TOA transition period, beginning when the first element of the inbound unit arrives in Korea until TOA is complete. During the RIP/TOA transition period this order applies to all Soldiers in both the inbound and outbound units. Commanders will publicize this order at the beginning of each RIP/TOA transition period.
4. Exceptions. Brigade commanders are authorized to grant exceptions to this policy for official events or unit functions. Notification of any exception to policy granted will be made to the Chief of Staff, 2ID/RUCD.
