



WARRIOR JUSTICE: Vignette One



FACTS:

A male CW2 developed an interest in a female SGT in his unit. One day, while walking near their office facilities, the CW2 started a conversation with the SGT. He introduced himself by his first name, said that he had noticed her around base, and asked for her number. The SGT said she had to leave for a meeting. The CW2 offered to walk her there. Once inside the building, the CW2 told the SGT that it was nice to talk to her, shook her hand, but then pulled her close to him and kissed her on the lips. The SGT pulled away and went to her meeting. A few weeks later, the SGT reported the incident to the SHARP office.

RECOMMENDED DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- What are your initial thoughts on this situation?
- Do you think fraternization is more or less likely to happen in Korea, compared to bases CONUS? Why or why not?
- Is verbal consent required prior to making physical contact with someone else?
- In what ways does this case constitute sexual harassment? In what ways does it constitute sexual assault?

WARRIOR JUSTICE:

The CW2 was found guilty of committing Abusive Sexual Contact at a GO Article 15. He was sentenced to forfeit \$2,350 pay per month for 2 months, 60 days restriction, and a written reprimand.

- What are your thoughts on the CW2's punishment?



WARRIOR JUSTICE: Vignette Two



FACTS:

While on a pass in Seoul, a male PFC hid in a women's restroom near several Korean restaurants and bars. After a few minutes, a Korean woman entered the restroom. The PFC surprised the woman by jumping from behind a closed stall door. He punched her in the face and then attempted to remove her clothing. The Korean National Police came immediately and arrested the PFC. The PFC was charged with Attempted Rape Resulting in Physical Injury by the Korean Government, and was placed in SOFA pretrial confinement.

RECOMMENDED DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- What are your thoughts on this situation?
- What impact do you think this instance had on the alliance between the United States and the Republic of Korea?
- Do you think additional SHARP training could have prevented this incident? Why or why not?
- Do you think incidents like this are more or less likely to occur on base?

WARRIOR JUSTICE:

The PFC was found guilty as charged in Korean court and was sentenced to imprisonment for five (5) years, not suspended. Additionally, the PFC was ordered to enroll in a “remedy of sexual crimes program” for forty (40) hours of education

- What are your thoughts on the PFC's punishment?



WARRIOR JUSTICE: Vignette Three



FACTS:

A male SSG was drinking in the Ville with a female SPC. While the SSG and SPC were walking back to the barracks, the SSG pushed the SPC up against a wall in an alley, tried to kiss her, and put his hand down her pants. She pushed him away, but he still told her he would take her home. She also vomited multiple times. When they arrived to the barracks, another female SPC noticed the intoxicated female and offered to assist. The male SSG and both females walked to the barracks room of the intoxicated SPC, where the other female recommended that the male SSG depart. The male SSG insisted on remaining with the SPC, and told the other female to leave. The SPC was then taken into the shower and reportedly sexually assaulted by the male SSG.

RECOMMENDED DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- What are your thoughts on this situation?
- What could the SM's involved do differently?
- Have you observed similar behavior? What did you do?
- How can leaders prevent future incidents?

WARRIOR JUSTICE:

At a General Court-Martial, the male SSG was found guilty of an abusive sexual contact, of violating a general regulation, and of indecently viewing the victim in her room. He was found not guilty of sexual assault. He was sentenced to reduction to Private (E1) and to a bad conduct discharge.

- What are your thoughts on the SSG's punishment?
