



# ***WARRIOR JUSTICE: Vignette One***

## *FACTS:*

A male PFC became embroiled in a domestic dispute with his wife at their off-post residence after she denied his sexual advances. During the dispute, the PFC began to assault her and grope her breasts. After his wife tried to leave their apartment, the PFC blocked her, forced her into the bedroom, and told her that she could only leave after having sex with him. She still refused his demands and was able to escape the apartment before a sexual assault occurred. She later filed a report with CID but became reluctant to cooperate with the investigation.

## *RECOMMENDED DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:*

- What are your thoughts on this situation?
- Do you think being stationed in Korea can add stress to a military family? Why or why not?
- What services are available to military spouses who believe they have been victims of sexual assault?
- Are there services offered at or near your installation that provide counseling to Soldiers and their spouses who are having trouble in their relationships?
- What do you think of the outcome of the PFC's case?

## *WARRIOR JUSTICE:*

The PFC received a discharge in lieu of court martial with a characterization of Other than Honorable. The PFC lost virtually all veteran's benefits and will likely face challenges seeking any state-sponsored employment in the future.



# ***WARRIOR JUSTICE: Vignette Two***

## **FACTS:**

A male PFC and a female PV2 went out for dinner and drinks one evening. At the end of the night, they shared a cab back to post. While in the cab, the male repeatedly asked the female to perform oral sex on him. After telling him no several times, the female finally conceded and performed oral sex on him in the cab. Later, he took her to the barracks and they proceeded to engage in sexual intercourse. At one point, the female said 'stop', but the male kept going and didn't stop until she had repeated herself several times.

## **RECOMMENDED DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

- What are your initial thoughts on what happened in this case?
- Do you think going out to dinner with someone creates “expectations” of what will happen later in the evening? Why or why not?
- What options could the female have taken after these incidents occurred?
- What effects can sex offender registration have on someone's life?
- What are your thoughts on the PFC's punishment?

## **WARRIOR JUSTICE:**

The PFC was found guilty of sexual assault at a Special Court-Martial. The PFC was sentenced to 12 months confinement, reduction to PVT (E1), a Bad Conduct Discharge, and will be required to register as a sex offender.



# ***WARRIOR JUSTICE: Vignette Three***

## *FACTS:*

A male 1SG was at a “smoke-pit” just outside the company barracks. While there, he called a female Junior Enlisted Soldier over to talk to him. When she did, the 1SG grabbed her buttocks and told her that he would leave the door to his room open for her that night and that she should come visit him. The Soldier reported the incident to her CoC. An investigation was initiated, and it was determined that the 1SG had also sexually harassed a female NCO in the unit.

## *RECOMMENDED DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:*

- What are your thoughts on this situation?
- In what ways can behavior by Senior Leaders affect the morale and well-being of the unit?
- What options are available to Soldiers who have experienced or observed similar treatment?
- Are Soldiers required to report such behavior to their Chain of Command? Why or why not?
- What do you think of the 1SG’s punishment?

## *WARRIOR JUSTICE:*

The 1SG was relieved from his position. Additionally, at an Article 15 hearing, the CG found the 1SG guilty of Abusive Sexual Contact and Maltreatment of a Subordinate. He was sentenced to forfeit one half month’s pay per month for two months, extra duty and restriction for 45 days, and a punitive written reprimand.
