Review of 23 MAR 20 CIE Facebook Questions

Q1) Will High School Graduation still be held as scheduled for 4 June?

Answer: Humphreys High School Graduation currently is still scheduled to be held on 4 June.

Q2) Where is the new car wash exactly and what is the size and ability to handle the volume of work?

Answer: The new Car Wash is located in the new Auto Skills Center at Bldg. 2250 across from the Humphreys High School. We will demolish a wall between two bays to accommodate large vehicles.

Q3) When will the fuel point at the intersection of First Team and 5t St. open to refuel GOVs and tactical vehicles?

Answer: The new fuel point is scheduled to open on 31 August 2021. The fuel point located by Collier Gym (Bldg. 1080) is still operational.

Q4) Will the Advanced Placement Test be held this year?

Answer: The Advanced Placement Test is currently being looked at to be held online, but Comprehensive Tests are cancelled.

Q5) Can families receive the separation pay for those who are in the States and can't return to their families like a family separation pay or hazardous duty pay?

Answer: There are some entitlements for Soldiers impacted, but they need to go to <https://www.army.mil/> and refer to *ALARACT 028-2020, SUBJ/URGENT ALARACT – Personnel Policy Guidance in Support of Army Wide Preparedness and Response to Coronavirus Disease (COVID) 19 Outbreak* to find out which category they fall into and apply

Q6) Has the Tax deadline been extended to 15 July 2020?

Answer: The tax deadline has been officially extended until 15 Jul 20 but you can still file now. In addition to the free service at Humphreys, you can go to Military One Source online that provides a free tax program.

Q7) Where are we for the Humphreys Functional Fitness situation?

Answer: The Turner Functional Fitness Center is tentatively scheduled to be ready to open on 25 Apr.
